Attend Business After Hours or set up a booth to showcase your business.


Make sure we have a current logo from your business for our digital sign.

## **BLUE GOOSE DAYS**

The summer events will kick off with Blue Goose Days during the first weekend in June. Chahinkapa Zoo and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service will be hosting a funfilled day with hands-on opportunities for youth of all ages to participate in activities focused on wildlife conservation programs. ## CHALKFEST

The Annual Borderline Chalkfest will be held the second weekend in July. With the support of our community we are hoping to make this the biggest Chalkfest yet expanding artists to two blocks and offering a variety of activities for everyone to enjoy. Borderline Chalkfest attracts spectators from all over and hosts professional and amateur artists from across the Unites States.

## **HEADWATERS DAYS**

Headwaters Day is scheduled to take place the second weekend in September and will be held on the Breckenridge side of the river. Join your fellow community members for a day of family fun at Welles Park.

Criteria includes:

- Dedication to quality, customer service, and commitment to employees
- Evidence of contribution to the community and community-oriented projects
- Evidence of support of the Wahpeton Breckenridge Area Chamber of Commerce
- Additional information such as hurdles overcome, innovative management techniques, previous awards won, etc.

# **CHAMBER SERVICE AWARD**

This award is presented to a Chamber member who has proactively demonstrated extraordinary enthusiasm for our organization through volunteerism, participation in Chamber activities and/or committees. This nominee shall also have acted as a notably positive "ambassador" for our Chamber through interactions with the public and other members.
