### **HOW DO I USE CHAMBER BUCKS?**







A qualifying individual's assets can also be set aside for burial space item (BSI) contracts for immediate family members and their spouses, which helps preserve as many assets as possible for the family.

- Cemetery plots/cremation niches
- Crypts

- Headstones
- Urns
- Opening/closing of grave




