Trigger Sports set to open in mid -June

Wahpeton, ND – When Mitchell Lane walked into Executive Director, Justin Neppl's Southern Valley Economic Directors office a year and a half ago to discuss starting a property management company he never imagined he would someday be opening a sporting goods store in Wahpeton. After Lane utilized startup support and entrepreneurial assistance from SVEDA. Trigger Sports is set to open in Downtown Wahpeton in mid-June turning his business dreams into reality.

Lane's passion started in the sporting goods and firearm industry after working at Outdoorsman in Fargo. Lane began talking to Justin about numbers and logistics to see if opening a sporting goods store was even feasible. According to Lane, "Justin was able to provide me with market research and data and what I learned was that it is feasible and sustainable and there is actually quite a bit of demand. With sports being such an integral part of the community: I realized the Wahpeton Breckenridge area might be the perfect fit. Justin was able to help walk me through all phases of the development."

The perfect location for Trigger Sports was found in the former Snap Fitness building and a lease was signed in March. A large remodel is ourrently in progress, and it will provide Trigger Sports with 3700 square feet of sales space. There was definitely an appeal to the space. When you walk in I want it to feel like a full legit hunting space. I was also able to get the capital to completely fill the store. The space will open with a focus on firearms, archery, and hunting with the hope of expanding into additional sports in the future." said Lane.

After climbing through all the hoops there are to open a business. Lane is excited to get track: into the firearm industry and set someone up with a package to go. Lane says "Wahpeton is the perfect community for Trigger Sports because they need it. I really enjoy the community and families I have met. I would like to see the town grow."





Tractor Safety Camp is designed to teach youth how to be safe on the farm. 

Group Workcamp 2022 June 19th - June 25th

Lakes & Prairies Community Action Partnership (CAPLP) is teaming up with Group Workcamps to help improve homes within 30 miles of Moorhead, Minnesota June 19-25, 2022. We are reaching out to older adults, persons with disabilities, single parents, and income eligible residents. We are excited to transform homes and create better living conditions for the families we serve! Hundreds of youth from across America will come together for five days to repair and transform homes while strengthening and transforming their own faith.

Each home site will consist of 4-5 senior high youth and at least one adult leader. Site writers will visit your home prior to the Group Workcamp and help with identifying repairs and materials needed for your specific project. 
