

#### **4th Annual Festival of Trees**

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the occasion and ask for your assistance in making this a joyous event. It is always a favorite and memorable time of year for us in the Wahpeton/ Breckenridge towns.

#### What is the festival of trees and how might you partake? It is simple!

We ask that you fill out the application and return it to Tami Sirek at 1655 Prairiewood Ct, Wahpeton, ND 58075 or email tamisirek@gmail.com. Deadline will be Friday. November 5th to participate.

#### We ask for these things:

- New artificial donated trees with lights. Please bring the original box to send along, so that we
  can send it with the family to store after the holiday.
- Decorations and lights. \*NOTE optional some have also wrapped a gift to share with the family OR Money donations towards the event.

The donated trees will be setup in the Heritage Square in Wahpeton. The tree sizes cannot be any larger than 6 feet in size as families that receive them generally have limited space in their homes.

The festival of trees highlights artificial, new Christmas trees sponsored and decorated by community businesses, organizations and families. The trees will be given to families that apply and who would not have a tree for the Holiday Season. The gifting process is handled through our Wilkin/Richland Kinship and Richland Social Services. A family cannot receive another tree this year, if they have already received one in the past. There is always a chance that we will have more applications than trees, we will do our best to fulfill the needs before us. Average trees that have been donated in the past were 30-43 trees.

Trees can be set up on Wednesday, November 17th and Thursday, November 18th from 4:00pm to 7:00pm. The trees are on display through Tuesday, December 21st, where families that are gifted the trees, will be able to come and get them to enjoy in their homes for the Christmas holiday. Times for pickup will be between 11:00 am and 6:00pm on Tuesday, December 21st.

Your business name or the name that donated the tree will be displayed on each tree that is received.

With COVID-19, we are asking that ringers are limited to 1 or 2 from the same household. Masks are required, and hand sanitizer and wipes will be provided. We ask that you do your best to social distance, but we know that this may be difficult.

If you signed up for the wrong time or need to cancel, please give us a call at 701-642-7807 and we will take you off the schedule.
