Her life was very normal...until one day it wasn't. Widowed at fifty-two, she was faced with a future she never asked for, didn't want, and certainly didn't foresee.

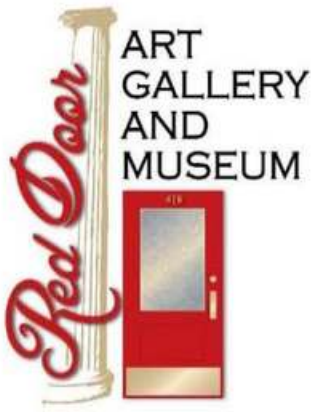
