
Lots of Things to do in September



3. Proposed businesses must be located in the City of Wahpeton.
4. Applicants must ensure the proposed businesses meet current zoning ordinances for Wahpeton. Contact Todd Johnson at 701-642-6565 with any questions.
5. The selection committee reserves the right to modify and/or extend the deadline dates of the program.
6. Prizes are non-transferable and may not be redeemed for cash. The prizes may be modified at anytime by the selection committee.
7. The Grand Prize winner shall assume responsibility for the payment of any other business expenses that are not part of the prize package.
8. The Grand Prize winner will be required to provide updates to the selection committee on a monthly basis or as requested. The selection committee reserves the right to request an update at any time.
9. Participants consent to the selection committee and its agents' use of participants' names, business names, likeness, picture, video, portrait, voice, biographical information, written submissions, and written or oral statements, for advertising and promotional purposes without additional compensation unless required by law.

- ◆ Over 80 tons of food was distributed in 2021 (which equals the weight of an African elephant every month!).
- ◆ Our mobile unit serves Fairmount, Lidgerwood and Rothsay once per month.
- ◆ We operate with only one part-time paid employee and over 30 volunteers.
- ◆ Funding comes from grants, business donations and donations from individuals.

FOOD PANTRY ADDITION & REPAIR PROJECT

Planning for a building update began in 2018 and includes these plans:

- ◆ **Construction** of an addition to the current pantry to include space for food distribution, operations of the school backpack program and warehouse space for our food supply.
- ◆ **Demolition** of the current storage building/shed that has failed.
- ◆ **Repair** of the roof on the existing pantry so it can be converted to warehouse space.

HOW ARE WE FUNDING THE EXPANSION PROJECT?

- ◆ We have secured some grant funding and donations.
- ◆ We are actively seeking other available grants and funding sources.
- ◆ We have been setting funds aside.
- ◆ We are asking community businesses and individuals for donations.




